
Be Wary of Third-Party Bill Payment Websites



MESSAGE FROM **GENERAL MANAGER ALAN LESLEY**

A THIRD-PARTY BILL PAYMENT service recently has gained the unfavorable attention of

some Comanche Electric Cooperative Association members. These members felt misled-and rightly so-after unknowingly stumbling upon the service while searching for CECA's own bill-payment service. This payment page often features specific company logos and uses the CECA name in its header, giving it the appearance of an official payment site.

Third-party payment services make money by adding service fees to bill payments, which comes as a surprise to members who happen to miss the site's subtle notice of nonaffiliation with the co-op. Often, payments made through these services are delayed or rejected due to incompatibility with CECA's own online bill-processing methods. The result is missed due dates, which not only makes it seem that the member simply didn't pay the bill in a timely manner but also incurs a late payment fee for the member.

Although services such as these may seem unethical, they are not illegal. Please know that CECA is not affiliated with any third-party bill-paying service. Online payments are accepted by accessing our company website at www.ceca.coop. These payments are securely processed by our customer software





provider, Southeastern Data Cooperative. When logging on to your account, our system will notify you that you are leaving our site and entering the SEDC site. This is the ONLY site you should use when making online payments to CECA. Online payment processing through our website and affiliate SEDC is a secure and free service to our members.

If you choose to make online payments to CECA using any other service besides SEDC, please use caution. Investigate before paying to make sure the service is legitimate, and inquire about any additional fees you might be required to pay.

As an electric cooperative rooted in the communities it serves, and as a nonprofit organization, CECA places people our members-first. Our members matter, and our promise is to continue to look out for you. That's why we've created options for paying your bill that are convenient, secure and

> trustworthy, and that's why we are asking our members to be alert about this issue.

If you have doubts or questions about whether you are on the correct site, call us before taking that risk! CECA employees are available to speak with you 5:30 a.m.-11 p.m., Monday-Friday. Weekend hours are 8 a.m.-7 p.m. These dedicated employees are happy to help you decide if you are using our site, or if you have inadvertently clicked on a third-party look-alike.

And as always, if you receive suspicious phone calls or emails from someone claiming to be a representative of CECA requesting payment, please call CECA at 1-800-915-2533 for verification.

CECA Payment **Options**

Bank Draft: For more convenience, use our bank draft option.

Recurring online payment with a credit/ debit card: CECA accepts MasterCard and Visa as payment for electric service. Payment will be posted to your account as soon as the credit card company approves the transaction.

Pay Your Way: Pay for your power before you use it. Contact a customer service representative to learn how easy it is to take control of when and how much to pay for your electric service.

E-bill: CECA's convenient e-bill options can be accessed through the website or through our convenient app, available for Apple and Android products.

At any of our three offices: CECA has three locations-Comanche, Early and Eastland—to more conveniently serve our membership.

By phone: Payment can be made by phone by calling 1-800-915-2533.



By mail: When paying by mail, return the bottom portion of your bill with your check or money order and keep the top part for your records. DO NOT send cash. CECA is not responsible for cash sent through the mail.

Budget Billing: For those who want the convenience of consistent monthly budgeting, the Budget Billing plan may be an alternative just for you. This billing option provides predictable billing throughout a set period of time. It is calculated on a member's previous 12-month average bill amounts.




